Handwriting, Social Skill Camps & Academic Tutoring

For preschool & elementary aged children

Handwriting Groups - Print & Cursive

The handwriting camps are led by pediatric occupational therapists. OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY GROUPS CAN BE SUBMITTED TO INSURANCE FOR POTENTIAL REIMBURSEMENT. Supply fees are included in all tuition.

SESSIONS: A (June 12-15), B (July 10-13), C (July 31-Aug. 3) D (Aug. 7-10), 9:30am-11:30am

<u>Handwriting 1</u> – Ideal for the child entering Pre K or Kindergarten that would benefit from more individualized assistance focusing on the following: fine motor development, upper body strength, scissor skills, letter identification, and upper case letter and number letter formation. This group is for beginning handwriting students or those that may benefit from remedial help. The Handwriting Without Tears program is utilized as a guide for letter formation. Activities are sent home as a way to ensure continued success across all environments. **2 hour group**, **Monday-Thursday**, **June 12-15**; **July 10-13**; **July 31- Aug. 3**; **Aug. 7-10**, **9:30am-11:30am**. **Tuition \$295**

Handwriting 2 – Ideal for the child entering 1st or 2nd grade that would benefit from more individualized assistance or remediation focusing on the following: lowercase letter formation & usage, self-editing (including spacing and punctuation), fine motor development, and upper body strength. This group is for handwriting students that have been exposed to lowercase letter formation or those that may benefit from remedial help. The Handwriting Without Tears program is utilized as a guide for letter formation. Activities are sent home as a way to ensure continued success across all environments. 2 hour group, Monday-Thursday, June 12-15; July 10-13; July 31- Aug. 3; Aug. 7-10, 9:30am-11:30am. Tuition \$295

<u>Handwriting 3</u> – Ideal for the child just learning or struggling with cursive handwriting. Fine motor development, upper body, strength, cursive letter identification, and letter formation will all be discussed. The Loops and Other Groups handwriting program and Handwriting Without Tears are used. Incorporation of age appropriate classroom organizational strategies will also be included. Activities are sent home as a way to ensure continued success across all environments. 2 hour group, Monday-Thursday, June 12-15; July 10-13; July 31- Aug. 3; Aug. 7-10, 9:30am-11:30am. SOCIAL & MOTOR SKILL SESSIONS: A (June 12-15), B (July 10-13), C (July 31-Aug. 3) D (Aug. 7-10)

Elementary Group (approximate ages 6-8) – For children that would benefit from a smaller socially structured therapeutic and academic group setting. This group will focus on classroom skills that will enable the child to function more independently within the contexts of a classroom AND recess environment. Special attention is given to the schedule and make up of this group in order to best fit the needs of the participants. Goal areas will focus on interaction skills, following directions, fine and gross motor skills, academic transitions as well as other foundational academic areas.

1.5 hour class, 4 times a week, Monday – Thursdays 3:30-5:00 pm Tuition \$395 for 4 sessions.
